They raised €660 for Motor Nueron disease & the Colette Nolan fund!!

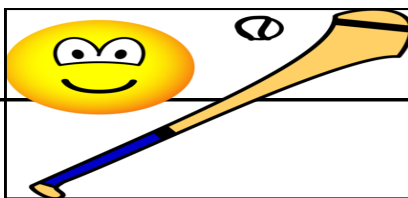
Well done to Ms Fitzgerald & 5th Class and to all the people who brought cakes, biscuits etc.
